

# Summary of Colne Road Housing survey

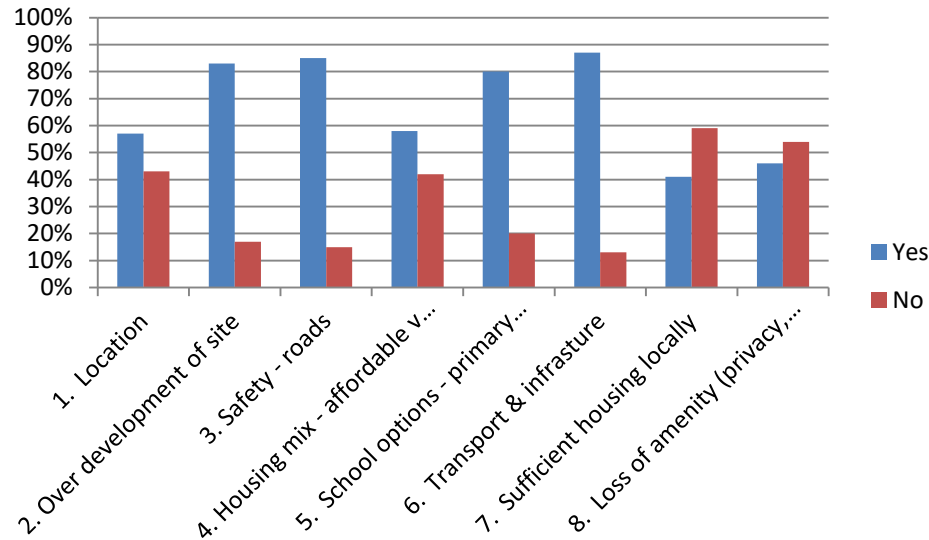

# Housing Survey

Bluntisham Parish Council wanted to ask the views of the village regarding the Bidwell's housing proposal. A survey was hand delivered to all properties in Bluntisham by the parish council and also in Colne along with their annual newsletter. Responses were posted to the clerk, emailed or collected.

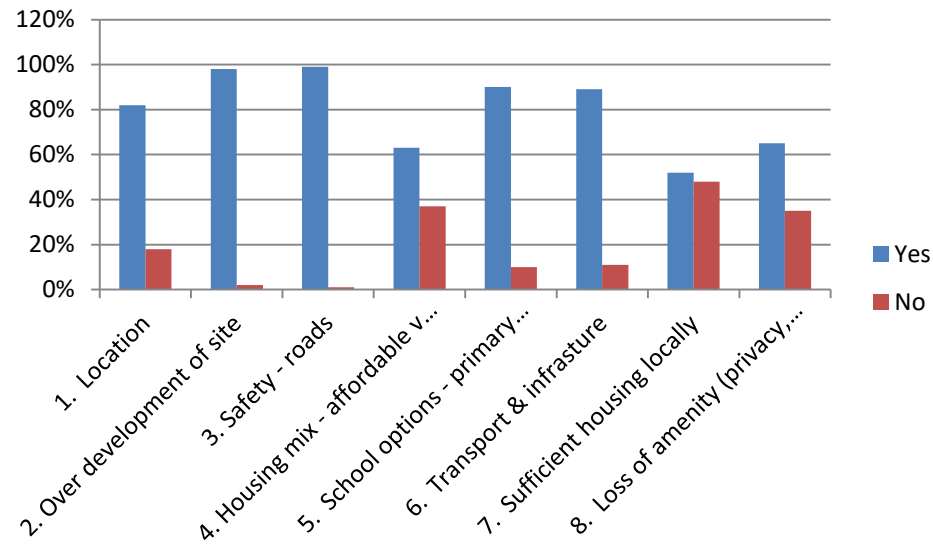
# Summary of surveys - % returned

Of the 1187 surveys delivered 170 were returned which equates to 14%.  
From the yes/no questions asked see summary of all results below.



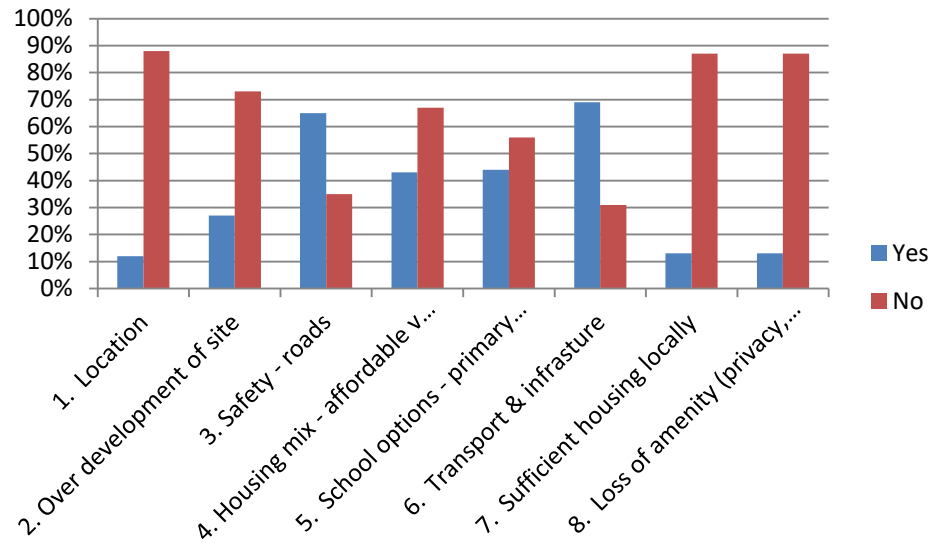
# Summary of those against the proposal

Based on the questions answered and the comments made, a total of 66% returned were not in favour of the proposal. This equates to 112 returned surveys.



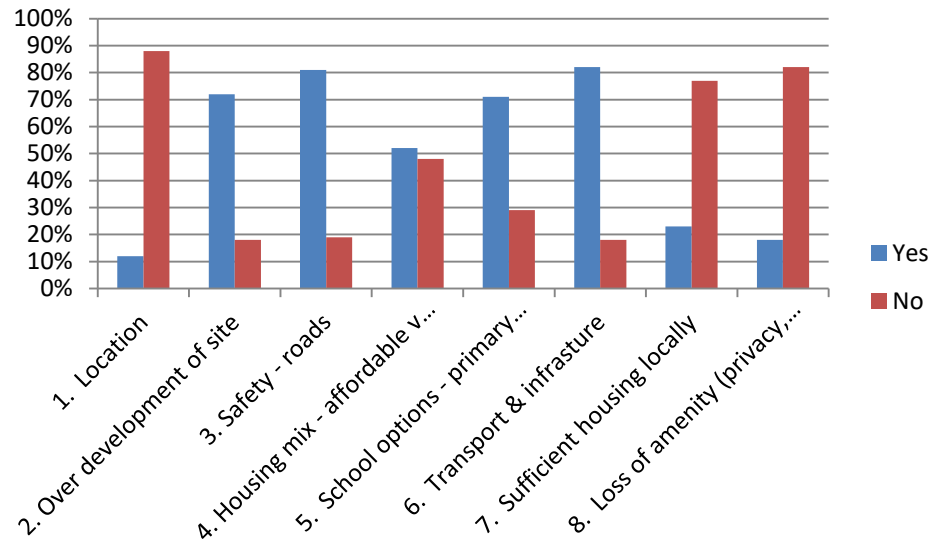
# Summary of those in support of the proposal

Based on the questions answered and the comments made, a total of 18% returned were in favour of the proposal. This equates to 30 returned surveys.



# Summary of those unsure of the proposal

Based on the questions answered and the comments made, a total of 16% returned were unsure of the proposal, their comments had reservations but also had some support of the scheme. This equates to 28 returned surveys.



# To summarise

In conclusion a vast majority are not in favour of a development of this size in this location. The key concerns from all surveys:

- Overdevelopment
- Road safety
- School options
- Transport & infrastructure
